
TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:


Sara was employed by the West Bloomfield Schools as a social worker from mid-April to mid-June 1993. She assisted the social worker at Doherty Elementary School two days a week by providing direct services to students in regular education. This was a temporary position created to provide services to students because the building social worker was unable to do so, due to other responsibilities. Sara was supervised by Melba Kubat, school social worker assigned to Doherty Elementary.

Sara was very energetic and came to the assignment prepared with various ideas and activities appropriate for elementary aged students. She quickly assessed the needs of students to whom she was assigned by meeting with the building social worker, teachers, telephone calls with parents and student interviews. Within the first two weeks, Sara had developed a schedule for seeing approximately thirty students in groups and individually, that was in the best interest of the students and compatible with the needs of teachers.

Sara came to supervision sessions prepared with her concerns and responded positively to suggestions offered. Students, parents and staff responded to Sara in a positive manner. She is a skilled social worker and a warm person who would be a benefit to any school system.
